Language - Choose from Spoken A100, A101, A200, A201 or Classical A100, A101, A250, A251-A499. Students are not required to take languages above the A201 level. If a student is placed into the A201 level, 3 crs will be moved from Language to General Elective. ENGL-A205 is required of all incoming English majors, regardless of AP or other credit by examination. All such AP credits will be counted as general elective credit for English majors. Students with college transfer credits equivalent to ENGL T122 and students changing their majors to English who have already taken T122 are not required to take A205.</p>
